The program begins with a 4-week Conversational English course, which is then followed by six weeks of Employment Transition Training in either Personalised Care or Landscape Construction.

Program Structure

The Australia Pathways Program is delivered over 10-weeks, segmented into two distinct phases:

1. Conversational English Course (Weeks 1-4):

Focus on developing language skills in conversational English, catering to the practical needs of daily communication in English-speaking contexts.

2. Employment Transitional Training (Weeks 5-10):

Students choose between two specialised pathways:



Personalised Care Training: Preparing for roles in healthcare as personal care workers.

Learn about:

- Patient Care Ethics: Understanding patient rights and caregiver responsibilities.
- Basic Medical Knowledge: Recognising common health issues, first aid.
- Communication in Healthcare: Developing empathy, effective patient communication.
- Activities of Daily Living and Infection Control Standards



Landscape Construction Training: Preparing for careers in landscape design, maintenance and construction. There is also an elective option for Agriculture or Horticulture.

Learn about:

- Design Principles: Basics of aesthetic and functional landscape design.
- Practical Skills: Use of tools, construction methods.
- Environmental Sustainability: Understanding eco-friendly practices in landscaping.
- Work Health and Safety
